



Dear Delegate,

With the XVI International Congress for Mine Surveying commencing on Monday 12 September 2016, our preparations are almost complete and we are looking forward to welcoming you to Brisbane. The following details may assist with your arrival at the Congress.

1. CONGRESS LOCATION

The Congress is being held at the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre (BCEC), which is located in the riverside South Bank district, the heart of Brisbane's cultural and entertainment activities and only minutes from the CBD. The closest train station to BCEC is South Brisbane station and is only a few minutes' walk away.

2. AIRPORT AND TRANSPORT

Brisbane's Domestic and adjacent International Airports are located approximately 13 kilometres from the centre of the city, which is roughly a 20 minute drive. Brisbane's Airtrain is a very convenient way to travel between both airport terminals and the CBD.

Public transport (train, bus and ferry) is the easiest way to travel throughout the city and SEEQ cards (visitor travel cards) are available at most newsagents and train stations for visitors to purchase. Please see translink.com.au or call 13 12 30 for more information.

There are a number of taxi companies in Brisbane; the most commonly used companies are <u>Black and White Cabs</u> (13 32 22) or <u>Yellow Cab Co</u> (13 19 24).

3. CHECKING INTO YOUR HOTEL

For most hotels, the check-in time is 1400 hours. If you wish to confirm your room for an early arrival, you will need to pre-book and pay for the room from the previous evening.

As per standard hotel policies and procedures, delegates will be required to provide a credit card or a cash bond upon check in. This is to cover any incidental charges incurred during your stay regardless of whether your accommodation has been pre-paid.




