The "Future of ISM" committee held a meeting 2-11-1997 (a.m.) at Fremantle (Australia) .

Present: Messrs. Bardill, Czubik, Ludvigsen, Graczka, Palm and Pivac Observers: Messrs. Drzezla and Tudorovic

- Internet/Homepage it was unanimously agreed that the ISM Communications would be greatly improved by the introduction of an ISM Homepage on the Internet.
  - (a) Translation and interpretation would be readily available and language difficulties would eventually become minimal.
  - (b) The homepage language (working) would be English.
  - (c) The three working languages (English, German, Russian) would remain for Presidium meetings and Commission meetings.
  - (d) The "bridge-over" time for this change could be during the Krakow Congress (2000).
  - (e) By the South Africa Congress (2003) there may only be 1 working language, as it is anticipated that by this time computer translation will be available.

- 10 The 26th Session of the Presidium meeting scheduled to be held in Beijing -Tangsan - China was discussed.

A request from European members that this meeting be deferred to 1999 as it was proving too costly for members to travel to Australia 1997 followed by Asia in 1998.

The President adjourned the meeting to negotiate with the China delegation as the planning arrangements had been submitted for approval by the Presidium.

Following considerable debate China agreed to change the venue of Session 26 to Ostrava. Czech Republic 1998 and hold the 27th Session during 1999 in Beijing Tangsan. China. The President expressed gratitude to the Peoples Republic of China member for the agreement as a large amount of planning had been completed for the original venue.
